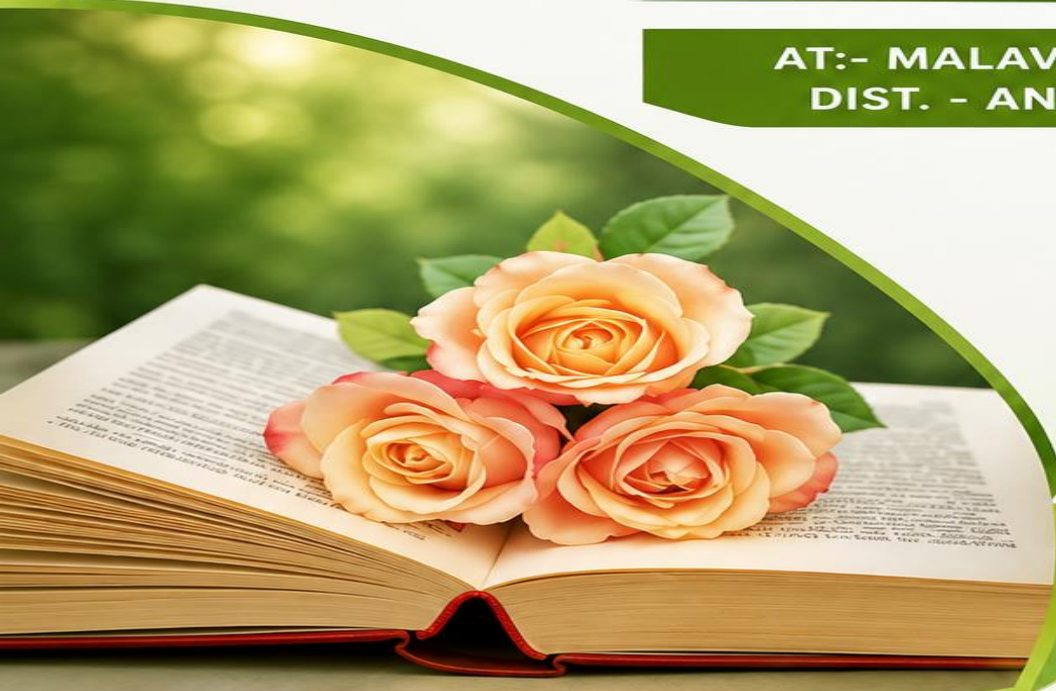

Plastic-Free Awareness Campaign

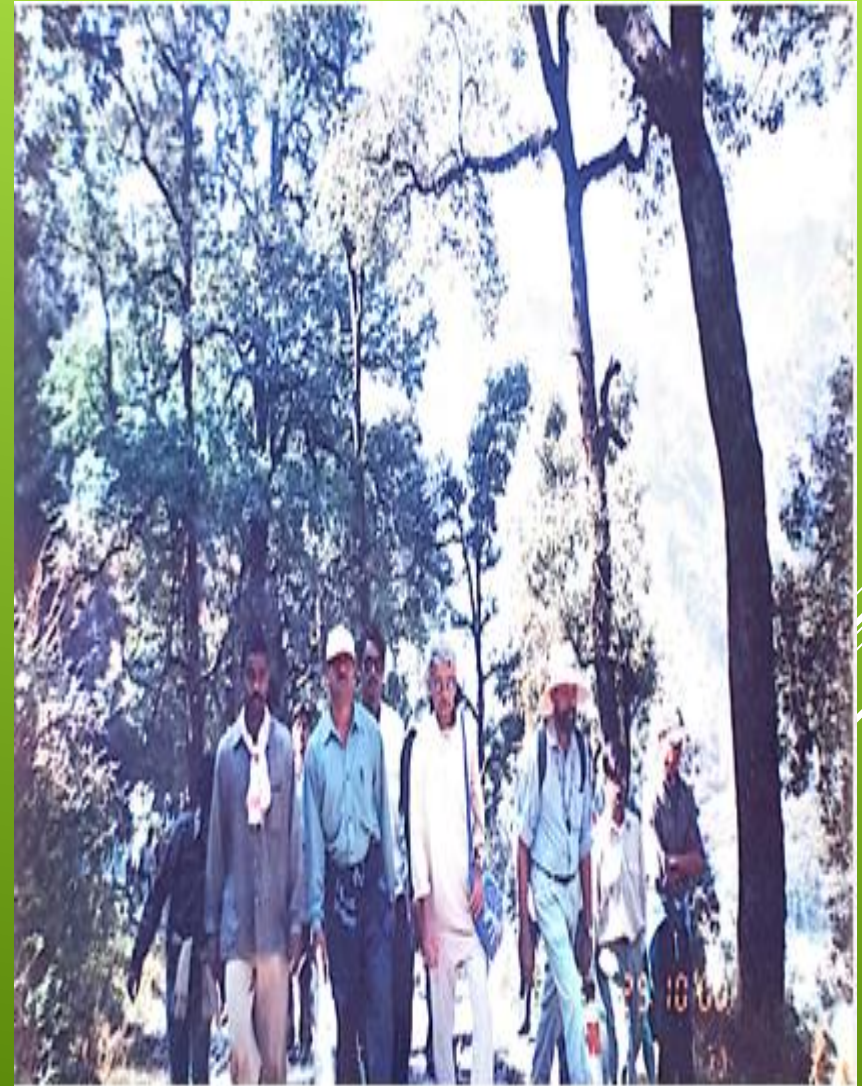
